Some Information on Short Courses for University Students 2012

Fees:

1. A concessional package fee of Rs.300/- for room, food and programme is payable. Even a part of a day stay with or without food will be deemed as a full day for the purpose of calculating the charges, as this is a concessional package rate. NGOs are charged Rs. 1200/- per day, per person. The staff who accompany will pay Rs. 200/- per day per person but if the staff wants to participate in the course and want the certificate, they will pay Rs.300/- per day. Fifty percent (50%) of the fees (non-refundable) is payable by Demand Draft drawn on any nationalized bank Payable at Vellore in favour of "Director, Christian Counselling Centre, Vellore" to be sent not later than the date mentioned in the accompanying letter from CCC. Non-receipt of this amount will make it difficult for the centre to block the dates for the group and may be given to others who are requesting for short courses.

Programme:

2. Programmatically we provide counselling skills in an experiential mode. Therefore observers are not allowed so that students are free to share and express. Faculty members can be present for the inauguration and the valedictory sessions at the beginning and the end of the course as also for consultations unless they have chosen to participate fully.

Timings:

3. As there will be other participants at the centre who are professionals, all participants will strictly adhere to meal times, class times and participate in the community activities. They will also be expected to maintain quietness after dinner as the other trainees have to work. We expect and appreciate full cooperation for your benefit.
